

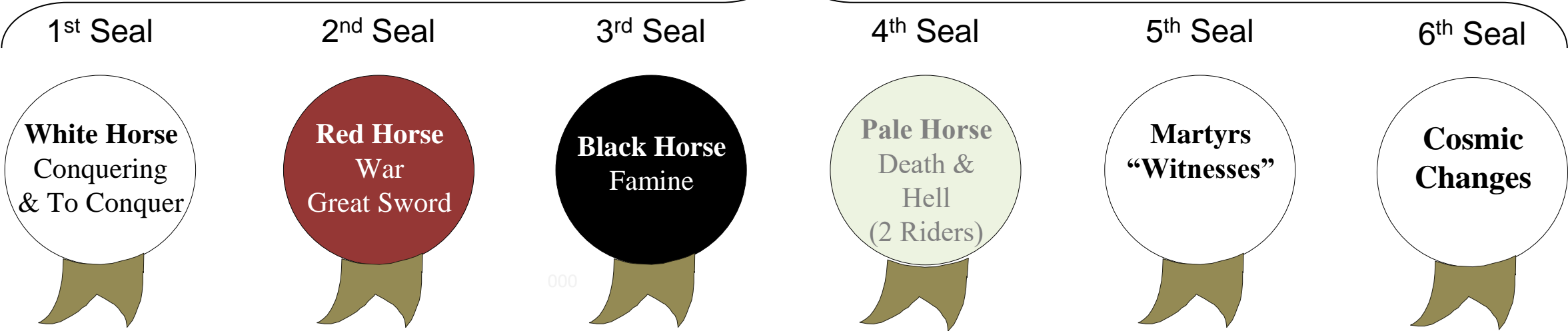

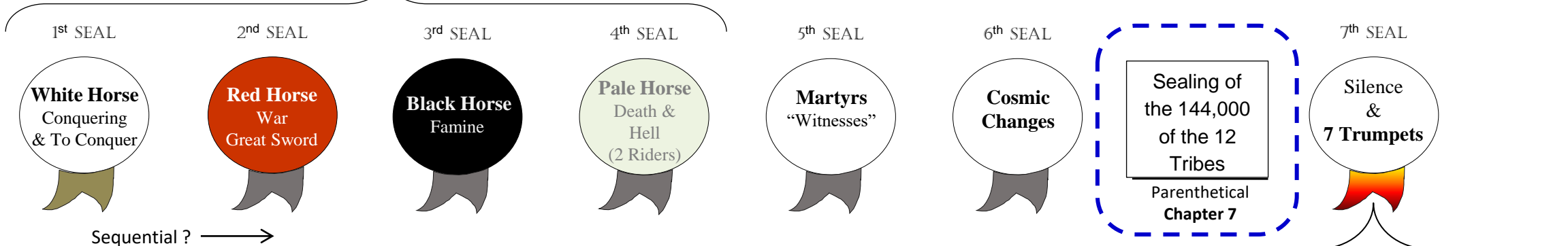

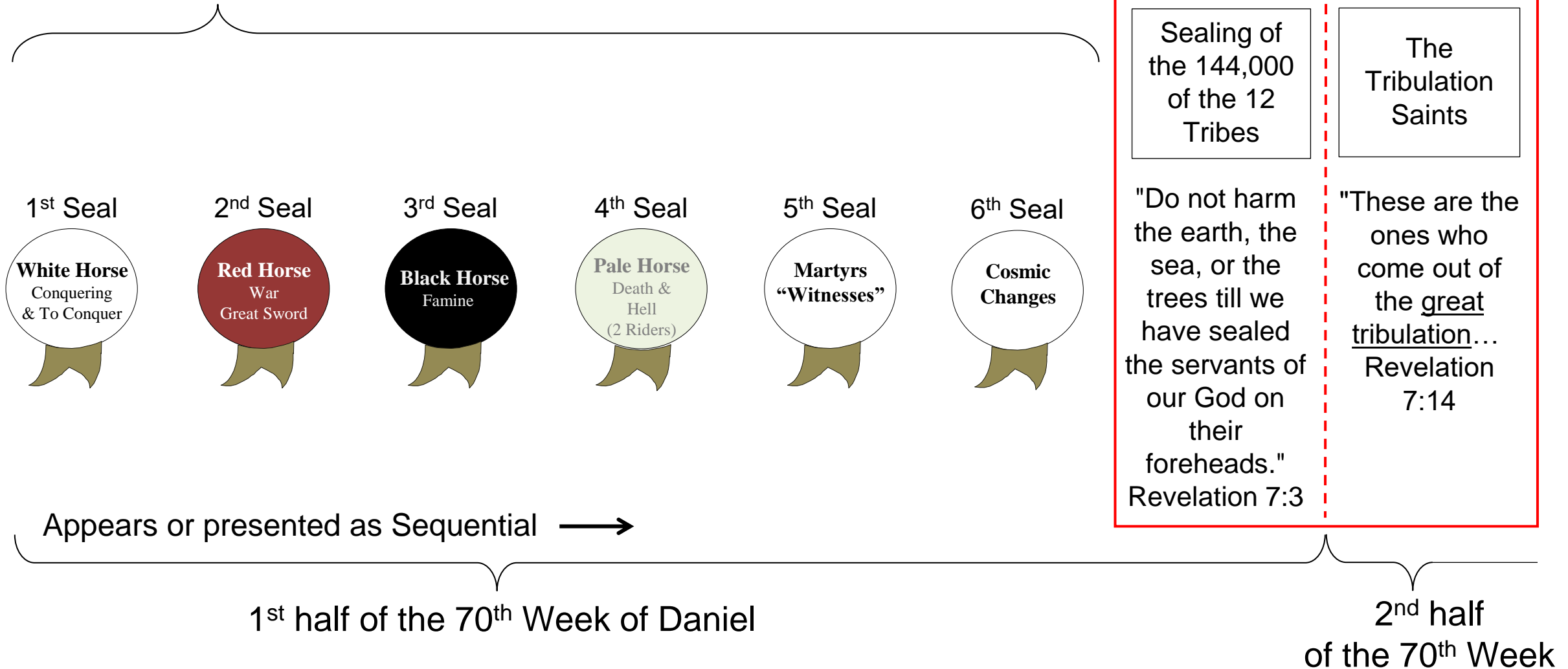
Originally the ancient Hebrew used a pictorial sign or symbol for each character; akin to the Hieroglyphs used by the Egyptians. The sign or symbol for the Hebrew word "mark" is the 22nd letter of the modern Hebrew alphabet – **ת** (tâv or tāv). The earliest rendering of this letter is symbolized by two cross sticks, represented by a cross. This appears to be the mark placed on those who were faithful to God in Ezekiel 9:4.
