


Opening the Seals



Appears Sequential -----



...and the LORD said to him, "Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and put a mark on the foreheads of the men who sigh and cry over all the abominations that are done within it."

Originally the ancient Hebrew used a pictorial sign or symbol for each character; akin to the Hieroglyphs used by the Egyptians. The sign or symbol for the Hebrew word "mark" is the 22nd letter of the modern Hebrew alphabet – The (tâv or tāw). The earliest rendering of this letter is symbolized by two cross sticks, represented by a cross. This appears to be the mark placed on those who were faithful to God in Ezekiel 9:4.
