The Tabernacle a model of Heaven

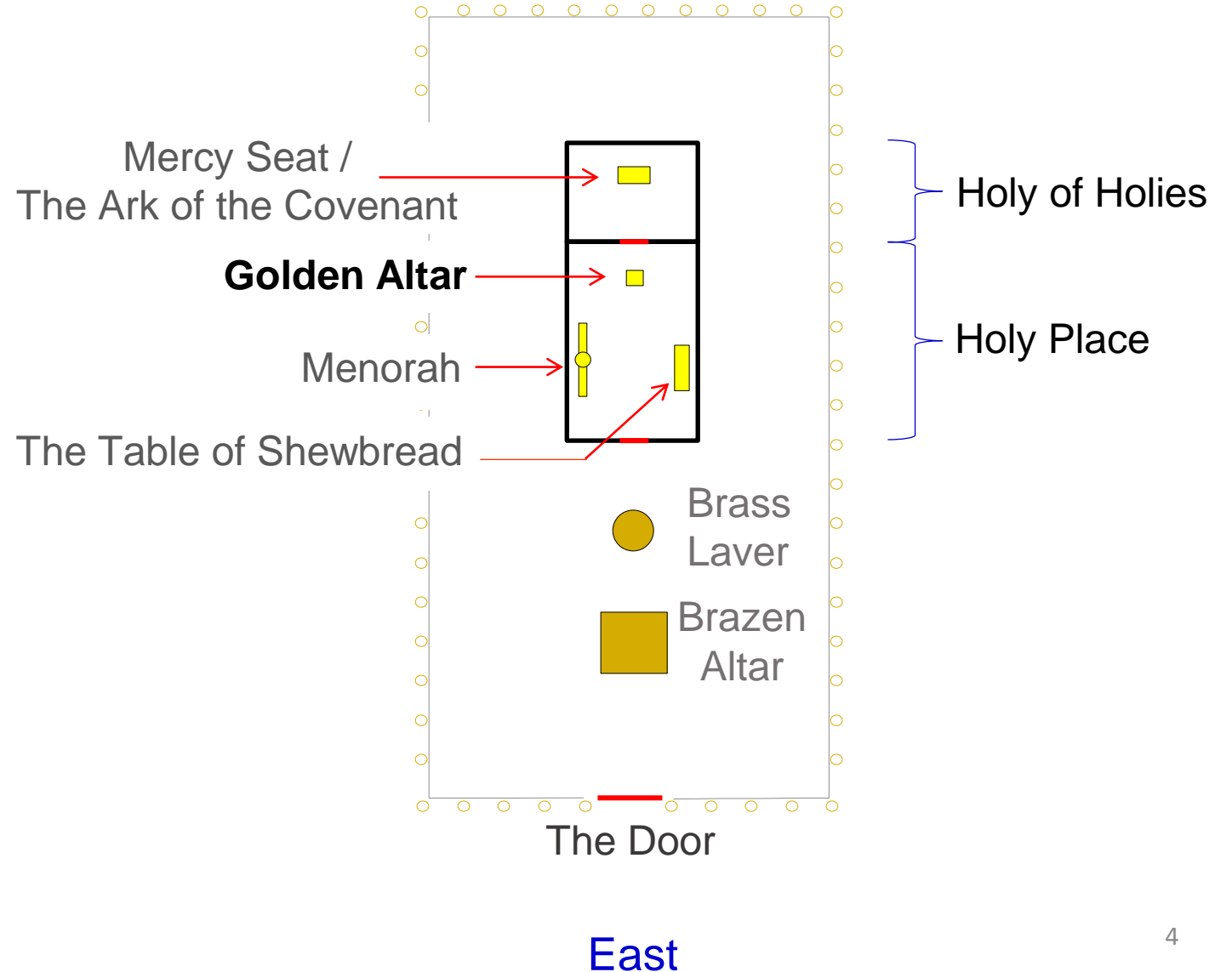

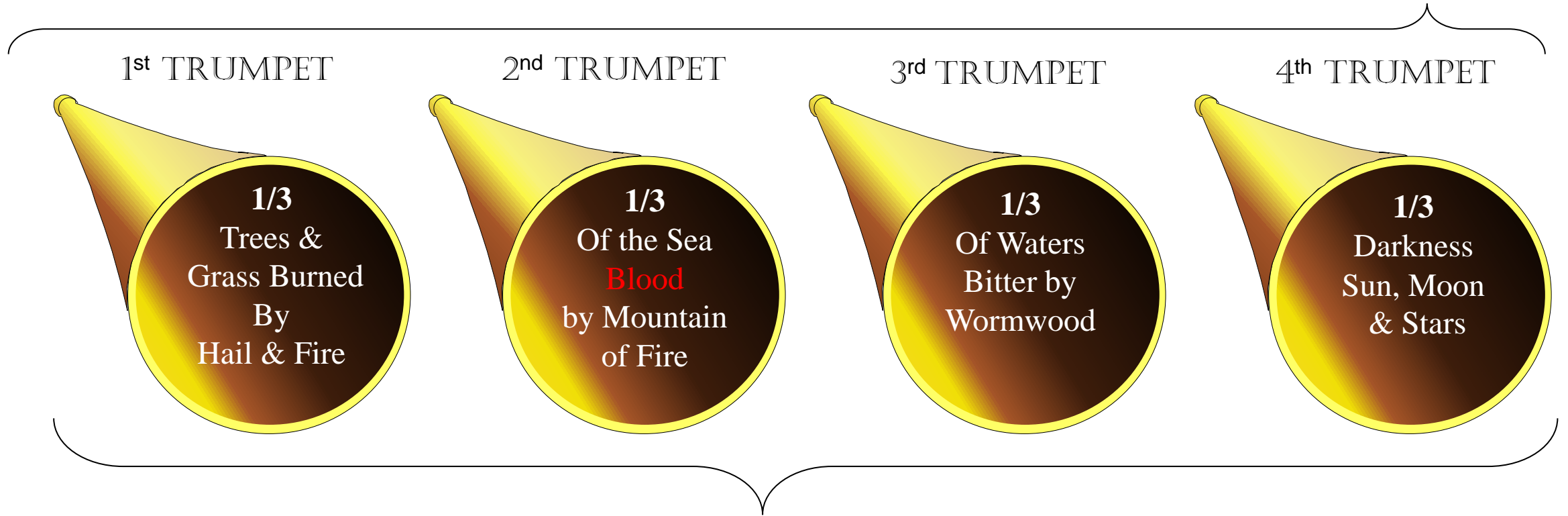

Egyptian Ipuwer Papyrus	Inferred Biblical Reference & Text
1. <i>There's blood everywhere...Lo the river is blood</i> (p. 151).	1. <i>And all the waters that were in the river were turned to blood.</i> Exodus 7:20b
2. <i>...one...thirsts for water</i> (p. 151)	2. <i>So all the Egyptians dug all around the river for water to drink, because they could not drink the water of the river.</i> Exodus 7:24
3. <i>Lo, trees are felled, branches stripped</i> (p. 153).	3. <i>and the hail struck every herb of the field and broke every tree of the field.</i> Exodus 9:25b
4. <i>Lo, grain is lacking on all sides</i> (p. 155).	4. <i>Now the flax and the barley were struck...</i> Exodus 9:31a
5. <i>Birds find neither fruit nor herbs</i> (p. 154).	5. <i>For they covered the face of the whole earth, so that the land was darkened; and they ate every herb of the land and all the fruit of the trees which the hail had left.</i> Exodus 10:15
6. <i>Groaning is throughout the land, mingled with laments</i> (p. 154).	6. <i>... and there was a great cry in Egypt, for there was not a house where there was not one dead.</i> Exodus 12:30b
7. <i>Low, man dead are buried in the river, the stream is the grave, the tomb became stream</i> (p. 151), <i>and he who puts his brother in the ground is everywhere</i> (p. 152).	7. <i>For the Egyptians were burying all their firstborn...</i> Numbers 33:4
8. <i>All is ruin!</i> (p. 152).	8. <i>Do you not yet know that Egypt is destroyed?"</i> Exodus 10:7
