"then let those who are in <u>Judea flee to the</u> <u>mountains</u>.


Let him who is on the housetop not go down to take anything out of his house.

#### □ Flood began on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of the 2<sup>nd</sup> month

And it came to pass after seven days that the waters of the flood were on the earth. In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the <u>second month, the seventeenth day of the month</u>, on that day all the fountains of the great deep were broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened. And the rain was on the earth forty days and forty nights. On the very same day Noah and Noah's sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth, and Noah's wife and the three wives of his sons with them, entered the ark—

#### □ The ark rested on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month

Then God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the animals that were with him in the ark. And God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters subsided. The fountains of the deep and the windows of heaven were also stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained. And the waters receded continually from the earth. At the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters decreased. Then the ark rested in the seventh month, the seventeenth day of the month, on the mountains of Ararat.

# What is a Biblical Year?

17<sup>th</sup> Day of the 2<sup>nd</sup> month <u>17<sup>th</sup> Day of the 7<sup>th</sup> month</u> 5 months

150 Days  $\div$  5 months = 30 per month


30 Days X 12 months = 360 Days

- 70<sup>th</sup> Week of Daniel = The entire 7 year Tribulation
- 1<sup>st</sup> half of the 70<sup>th</sup> Week of Daniel = I'm calling the Tribulation
- **2<sup>nd</sup>** half of the 70<sup>th</sup> Week of Daniel = Jesus called the Great Tribulation (q.v. Matthew 24:15)

## What is a Biblical Year?

- - $\geq$  365.25 days / 12 mo. = 30.4375 days for average month
  - 42 months X 30.4375 days = 1,278.375 Days
- Time, times, the dividing of time [2nd half?] ...... Daniel 7:25; 12:7 Revelation 12:14

### The four falls of Satan:

- 1. Satan fell from glorified to profane.
  - You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, <u>Till iniquity was found in</u> <u>you</u>. "By the abundance of your trading You became filled with violence within, And you sinned... Ezekiel 28:15-16a
- 2. Satan will fall from having access to heaven & restricted to the earth.

So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; <u>he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him</u>. Revelation 12:9; Cf. Isaiah 14:12; Ezekiel 28:17

- 3. Satan will fall or be cast from his place on the earth, bound into the bottomless pit for 1,000 years. (q.v. Revelation 20:1-3)
- 4. Finally, Satan will fall or be cast into the lake of fire and brimstone.

The devil, who deceived them, was <u>cast</u> into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

  - [Time gap between fall & Eden ?]
  - Had an ancient beginning
  - Stars = angels
- Deceives the whole world
- Sinner from the beginning
- Liar from the beginning
- Murderer from the beginning
- Enmity between him & the woman (Satan's seed & Woman's seed)

# The Three Tenses of "<u>Salvation</u>"

Past Tense:Separation from the Penalty of Sin

**Present Tense:** Separation from the <u>Power of Sin</u>

Future Tense:Separation from the Presence of Sin

These three terms (i.e., Justification, Sanctification & Glorification) all represent Salvation. They all are subsumed by the broad-brush called Salvation.
